The world demands that we be young, fit, and impeccably dressed to be considered desirable. But God's view of us is very different. His power is made perfect in our weakness. Come as you are - doubting or decided, broken or healed - Jesus desires you.

Talk Specifics:

- "Busyness" and "distraction" often veil the beauty in our life.
- God will reveal beauty in all things - even in our struggles and in our weakness.
- Archbishop Fulton Sheen's devotion to Eucharistic Adoration and the story of a little girl - an unnamed Chinese martyr - highlights God's desire to clear our vision.
- We are called to offer our lives and embrace joy in living out the Body of Christ.

If our bodies are truly a temple, how do we protect ourselves from pollutants that make us sick? In an age of organic, grass-fed, and non-GMO, we want real food. Our spirit seeks real food too. Come and feed your soul.

Talk Specifics:

- There is focus on pollutants entering our bodies, but we must also consider those that pollute our souls.
- Aquinas states that sin *darkens our intellect and weakens our will*.
- When we protect our souls, we grow in deeper relationship to God and become more like Him - living courageously.
- Research on why the non-Jews risked their lives to save Jews during the Holocaust.
- Jesus calls us to be His Body in this world courageously.

Many of us are decision exhausted. It may feel like we have 3,462 tabs open in our brain ALL THE TIME. How do we know what God desires when faced with so many choices? Come and learn the steps given to us by St. Ignatius to clearly discern the Father's will.

Talk Specifics:

- God has a plan and purpose for our life that only we can fulfill.
- God works through both suffering and joy.
- Even if we have made mistakes, if invited into those places, God works through them.
- We can learn to recognize His Will in our life through the methods developed through St. Ignatius of Loyola.
- God desires to be a part of all our decisions - big and small - not to control, but to lead us to fulfilling our destiny.

- Greatest *Vuja de* is the Eucharist.
- Sharing our miracle stories with others ~ testimony builds faith.

Sometimes we may feel that we need to earn God's love. The perpetual cycle of "doing, doing, doing" in our hectic lives can be exhausting. Join us for an evening away to simply rest and receive His love.

Talk Specifics:

- Responding to God's call
- Receiving God's love even when we feel that we are not worthy or we are not enough.
- Love not being based on productivity; we do not earn God's love
- FEAR ~ False Evidence Appearing Real
- St. Damien of Molokai and his response to live out God's call.
- Our Mission as the Body of Christ in this world.
